Certificates may also serve as stand-alone credentials for professionals preparing for a career change or advancement opportunities.

This certificate prepares students for employment in event and meeting planning management for large hotels, resorts, conference or convention centers, attractions, private catering operations, event management companies, nonprofit organizations, and independent event and wedding planners.
